Deadline for abstracts to be considered in June 8th, 2011.

Submission procedure

- 1. Abstracts must be submitted in English
- 2. The text must contain 250 words maximum
- 3. The title of the abstract must be written in capital letters
- **4.** The names of the authors must be in the nominative case, first the surname and then the first name, and the name of the presenter should be underlined
- **5.** Abstract texts should have the following structure: introduction, purpose, methods, results and conclusion
- 6. All received abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee
- 7. Abstracts will not be accepted if sent by fax or hard copy (paper copy)
- 8. After the submission of the abstract, no change can be made by the author
- **9.** Oral presentations: the exact data concerning date, time, equipment and place of the oral presentation will be notified to all authors upon finalization of the programme
- **10.** For each abstract, the registration fee for at least one of the authors should be paid until June 20th, 2011
- **11.** Abstracts must be submitted at the congress secretariat at the following e-mail address fsakka@free-spirit.gr until June 8th, 2011
